These infographics were created to present research used to inform and explain design decisions for multiple projects. They display various information about public opinion, demographics, and many other considerations in a full design.

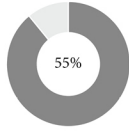

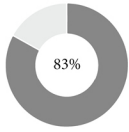
Co-working is the use of a shared office space by those who are self-employed or who have different employers to collaborate and share resources.



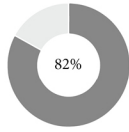

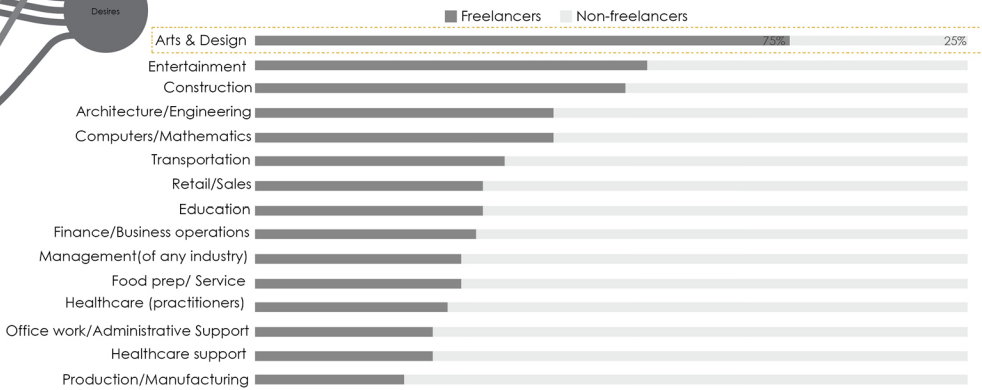


Freelance Workers

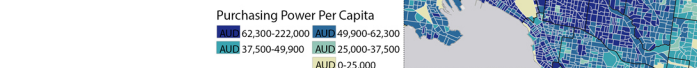

Case Study #1: Public Housing, Melbourne

[Building Isolation]

Among the first populations and buildings to lock down in Australia were Assisted Aged Living care facilities and Public Housing towers. These types of apartment buildings have many people living in close proximity. As an Australian health official puts it, these apartment buildings are like vertical cruise ships. There is a high chance of COVID-19 spread in these buildings especially because they do not have adequate ventilation systems. Additionally the residents living within these towers in Melbourne are part of the low income population so the lockdown affects them strongly.



The government of Victoria immediately placed the residents of public housing tower 33 Alfred St on mandatory and strict lockdown. Residents were not to leave their residences even to buy grocery essentials as a result of the high potential for COVID-19 spread within their housing. Many residents were negatively affected by this and weren't even informed of this mandate until a lot of police had showed up outside of the apartment building to restrict movement.



The government set out with good intentions to help the residents by providing meals and incentives to residents to stay on lockdown. However the meals and aid fell short, and many residents still went without necessary resources and meals.



As a result of this lockdown and the lack of aid many residents are getting, they are experiencing a change in attitude and many view the lockdown as a jail sentence. These residents wonder what they have done wrong because they can not even go to the grocery store, while other housing developments can travel in a 5km radius of their residence.



Many people have stepped up to help out and volunteer groups have been coming together to provide food and aid for those locked down and affected by the lockdown. A lot of these volunteer groups are minorities that are trying to take care of their communities.

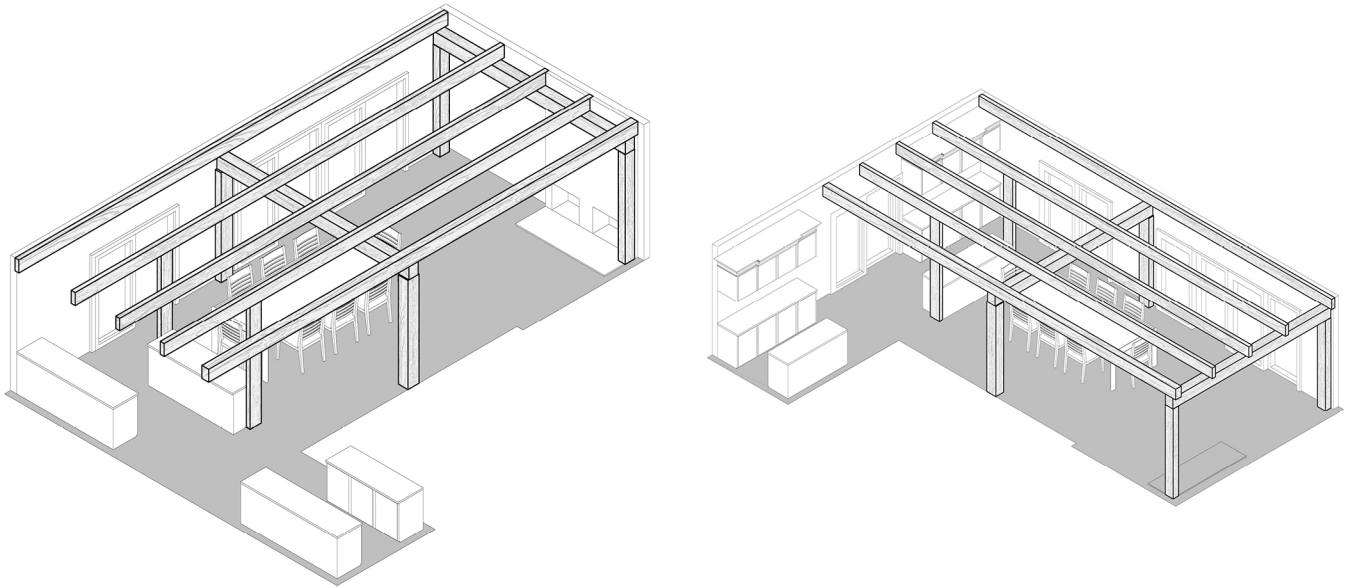


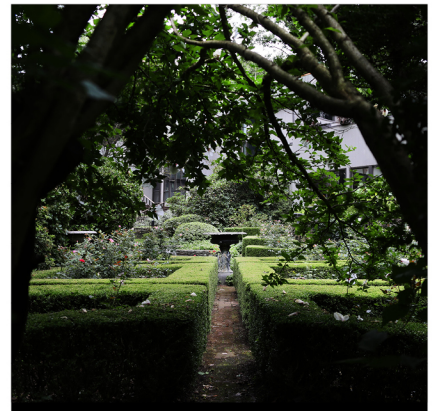


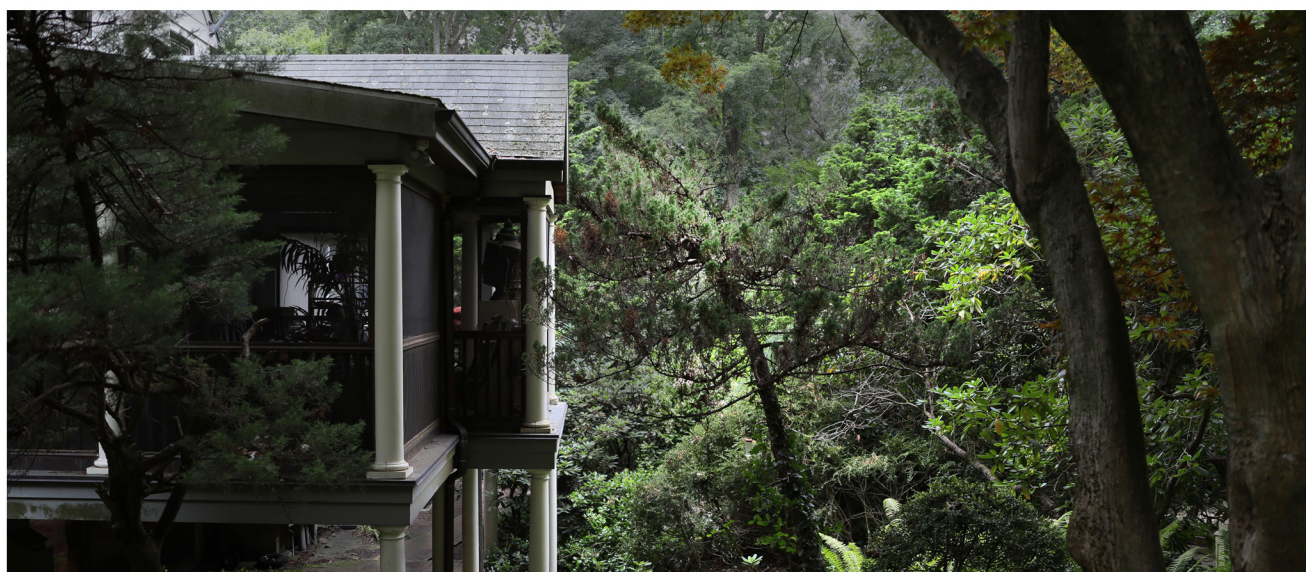

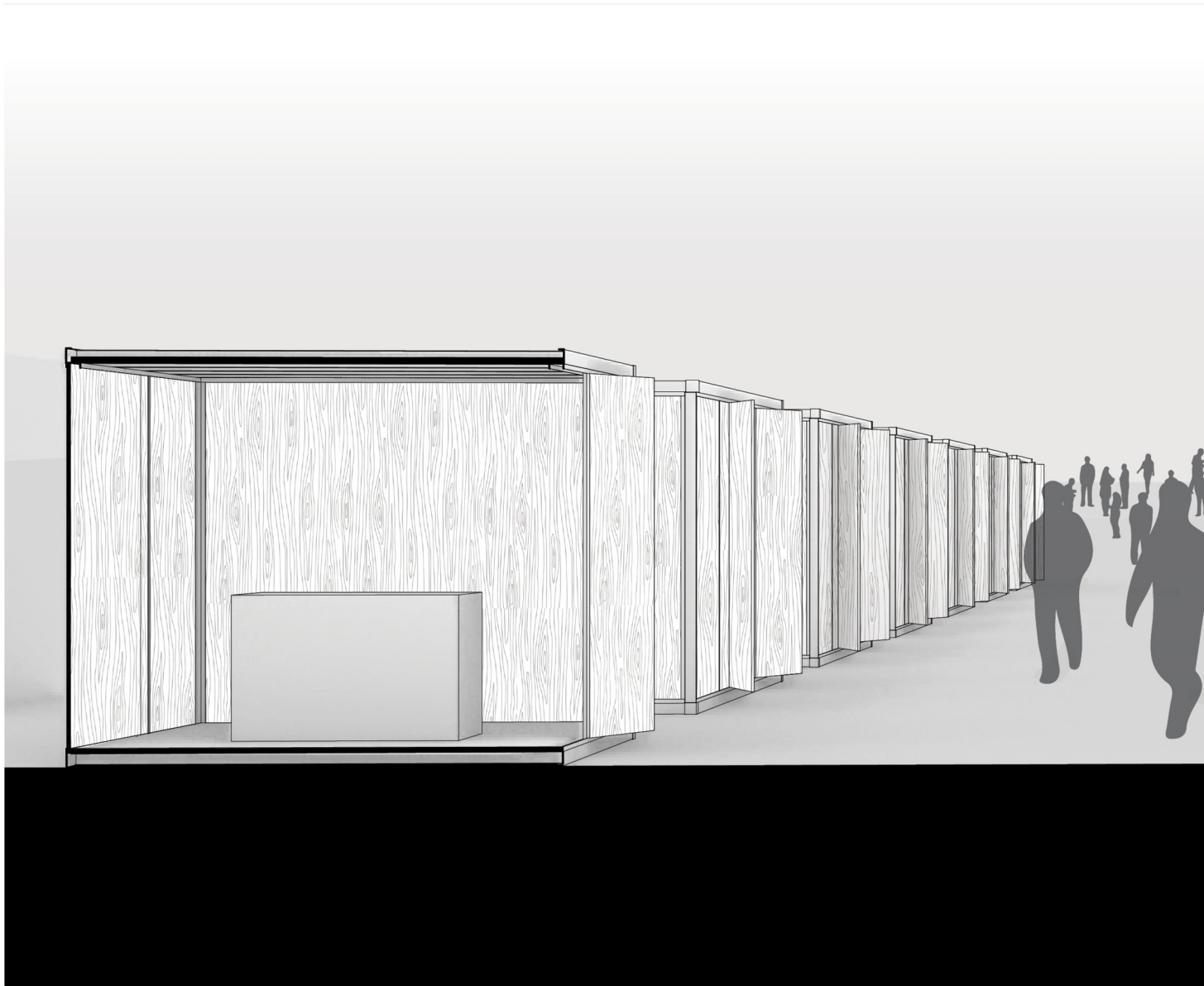


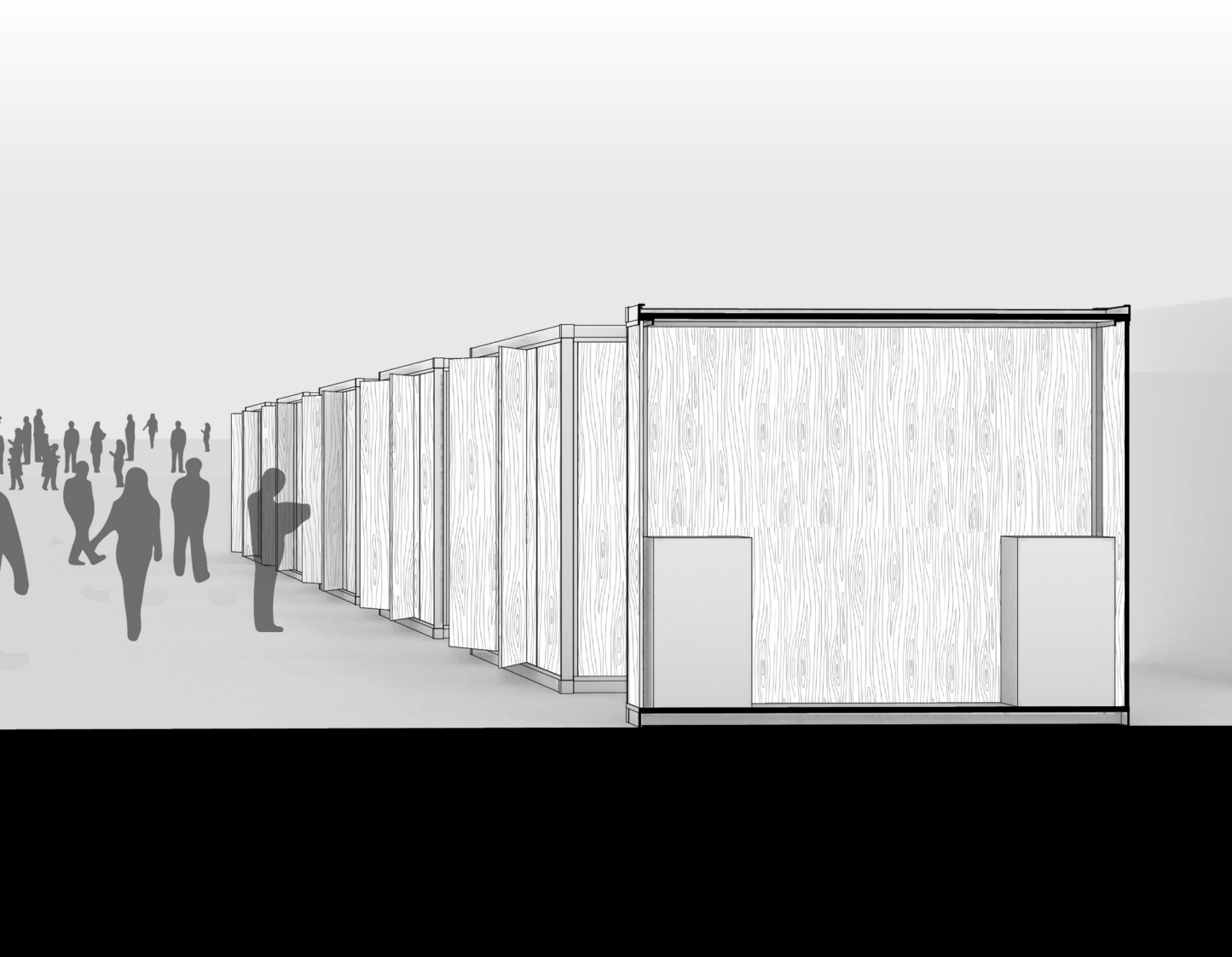


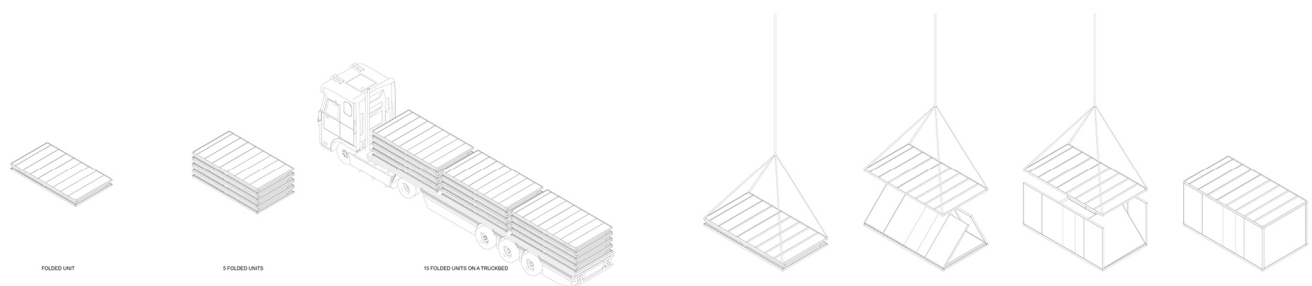
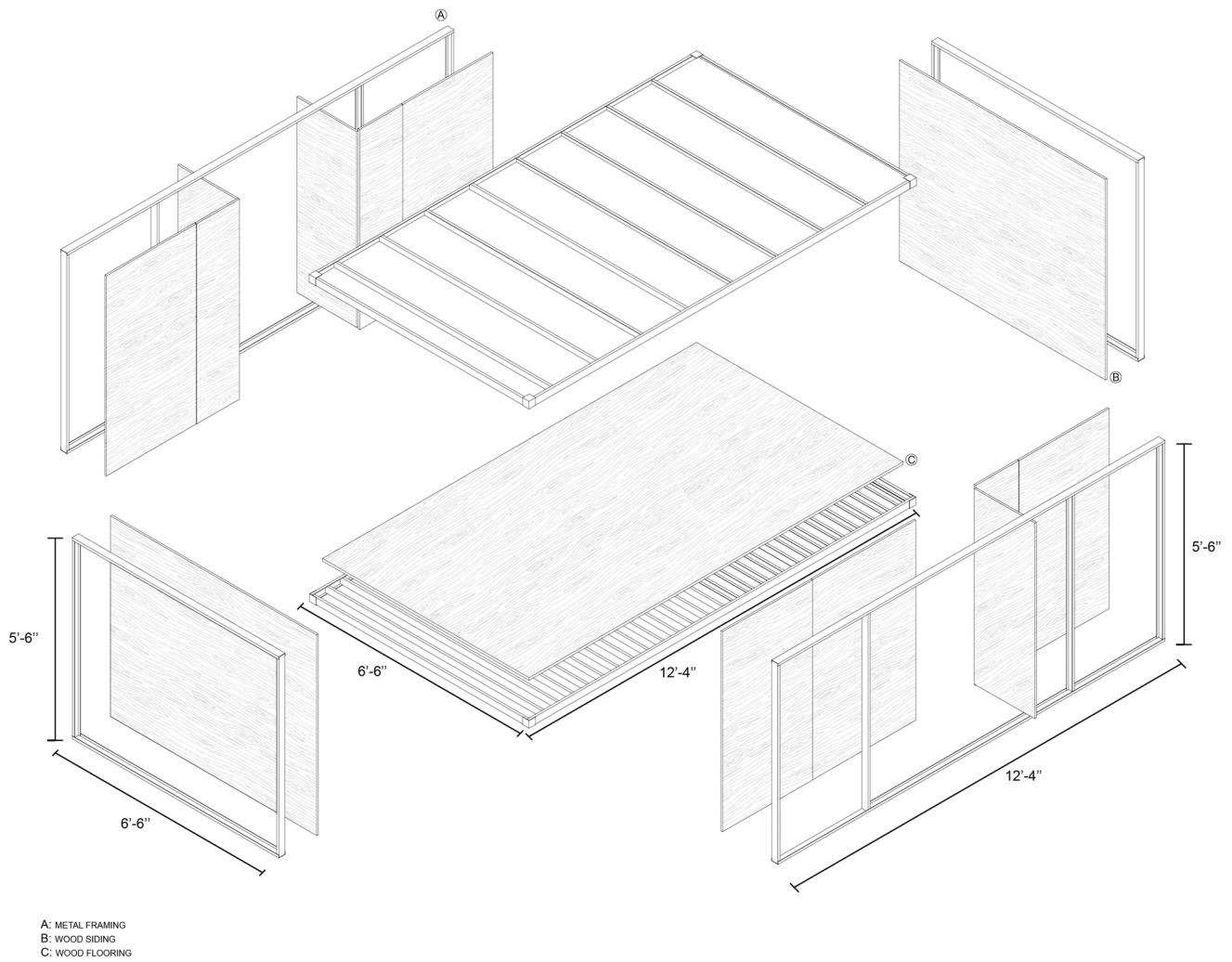
South Side Market

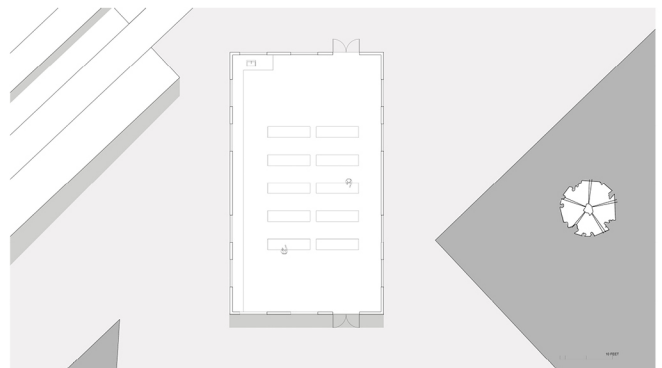
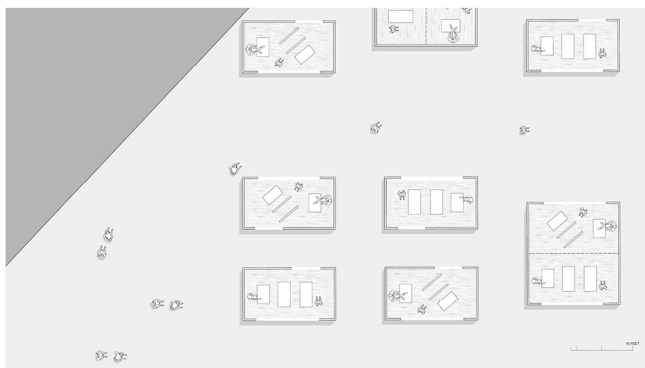
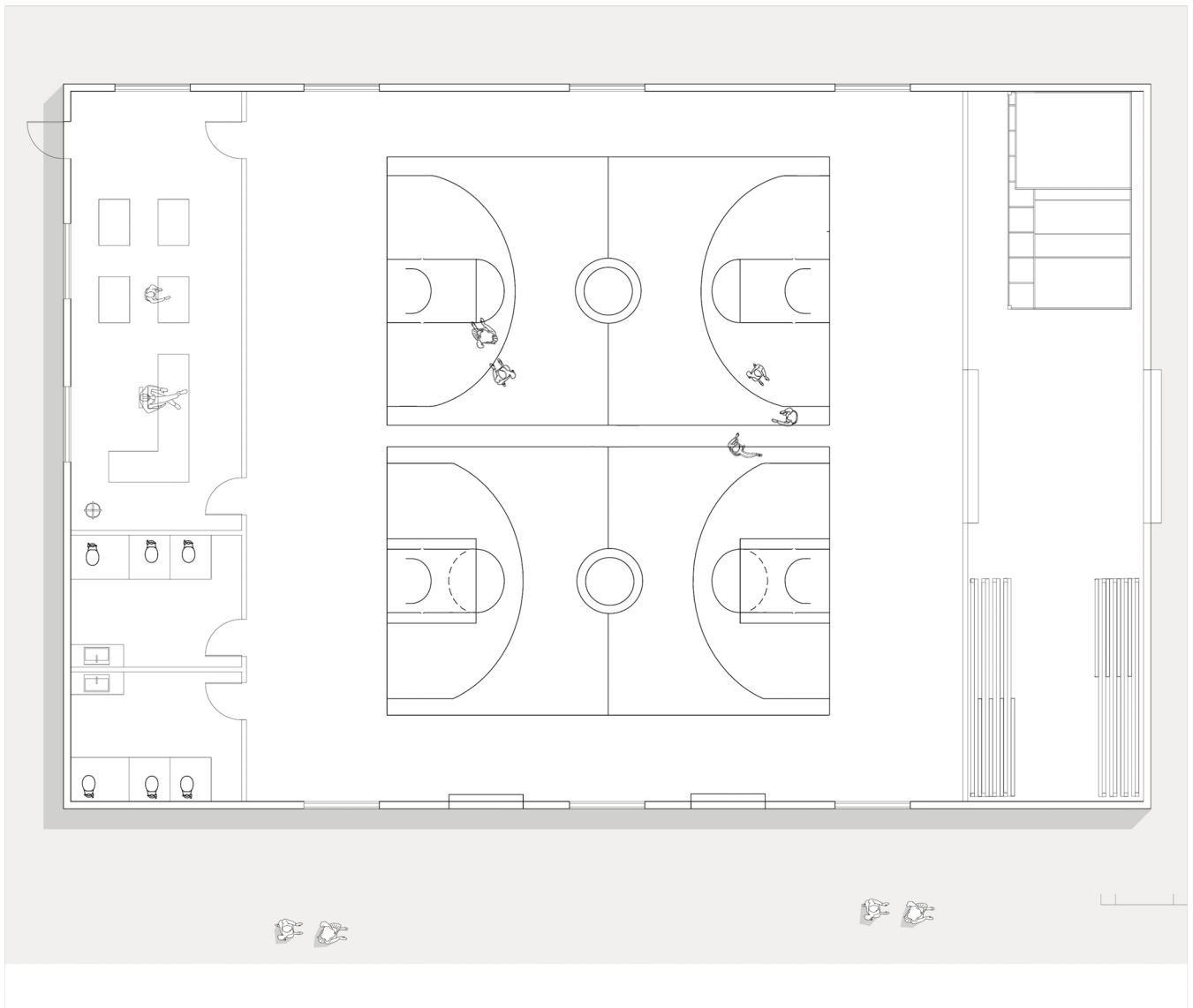

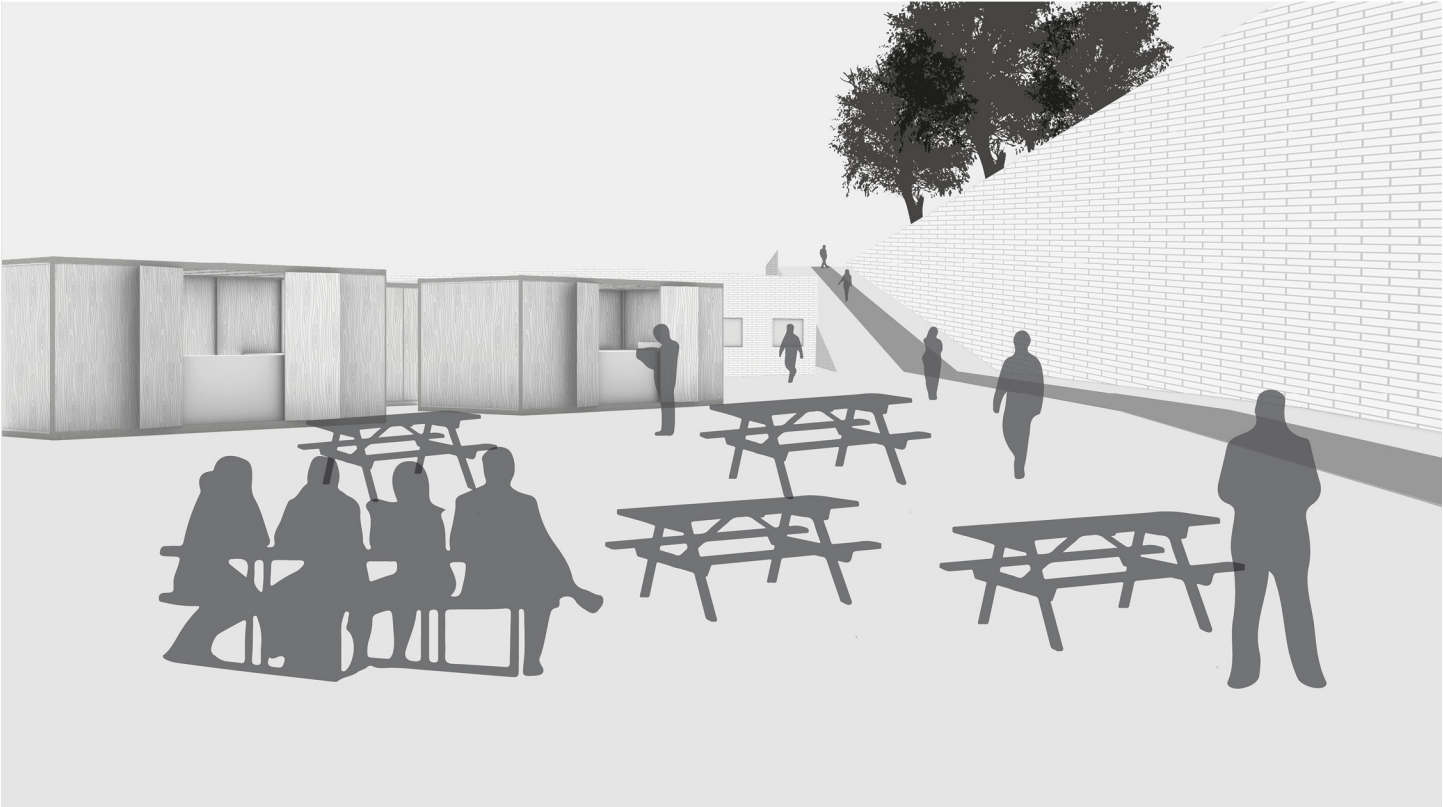










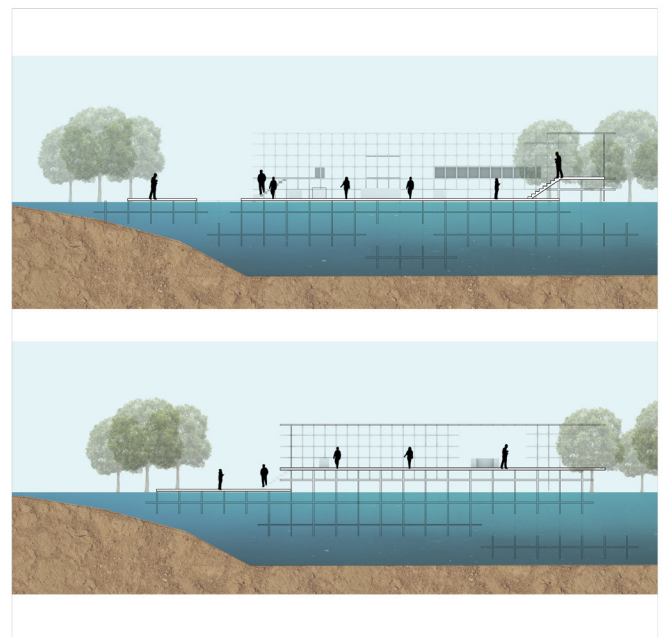
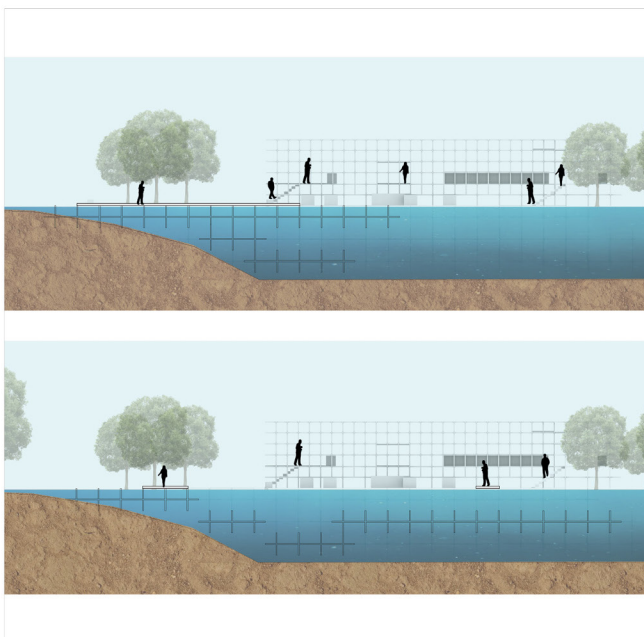
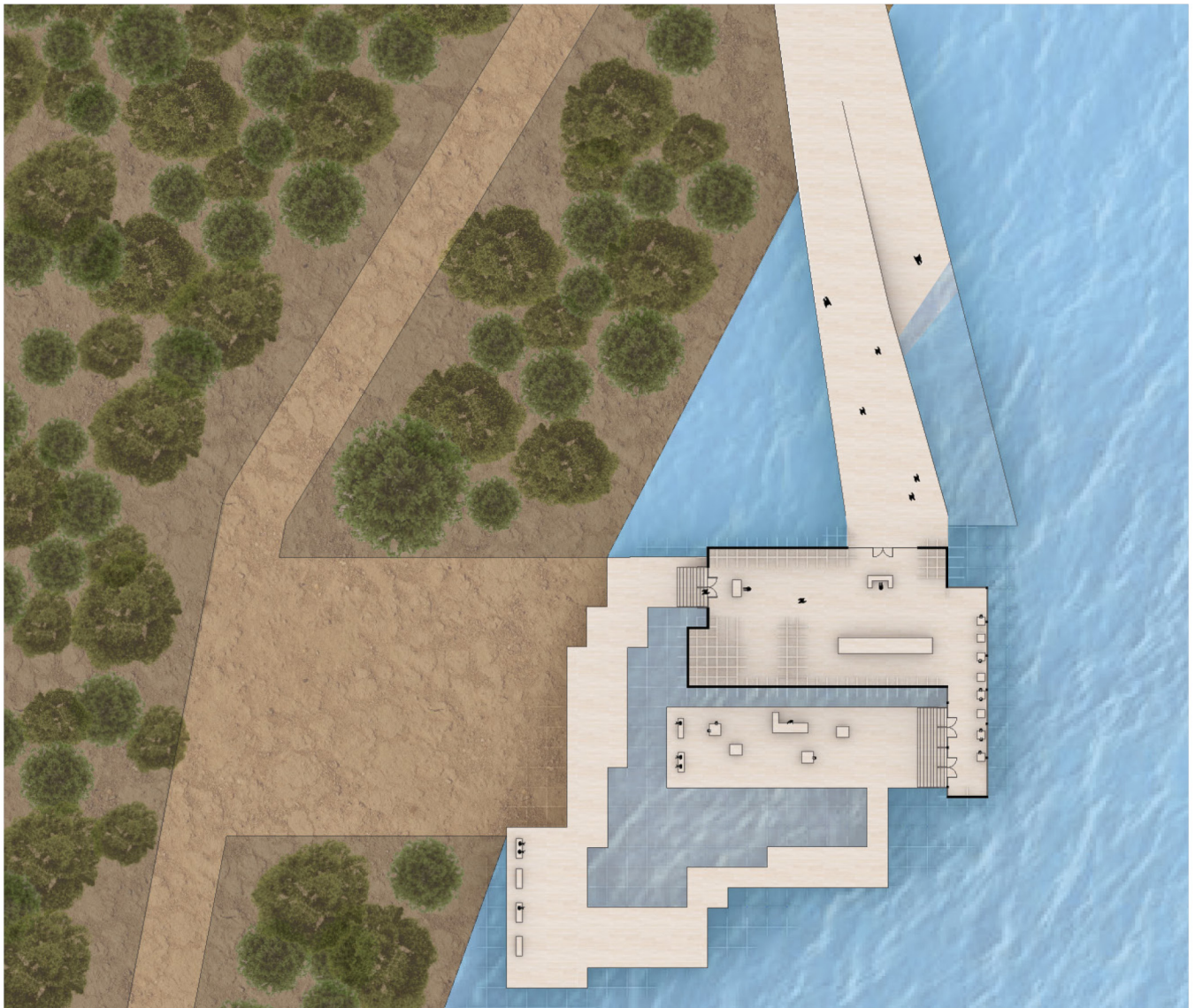


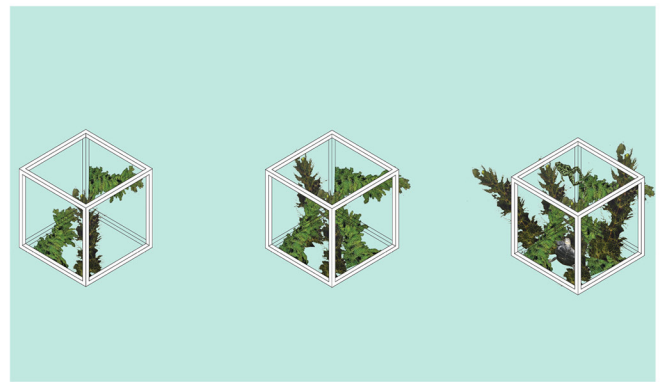
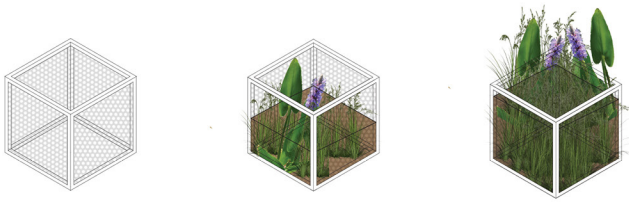
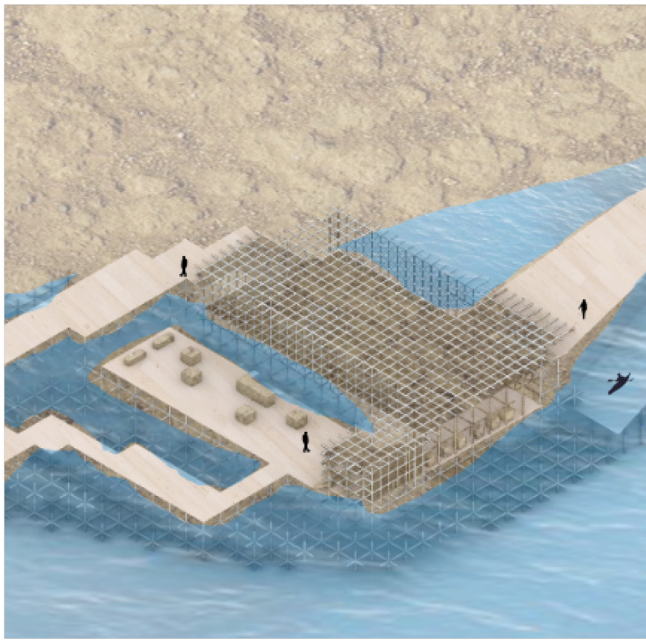


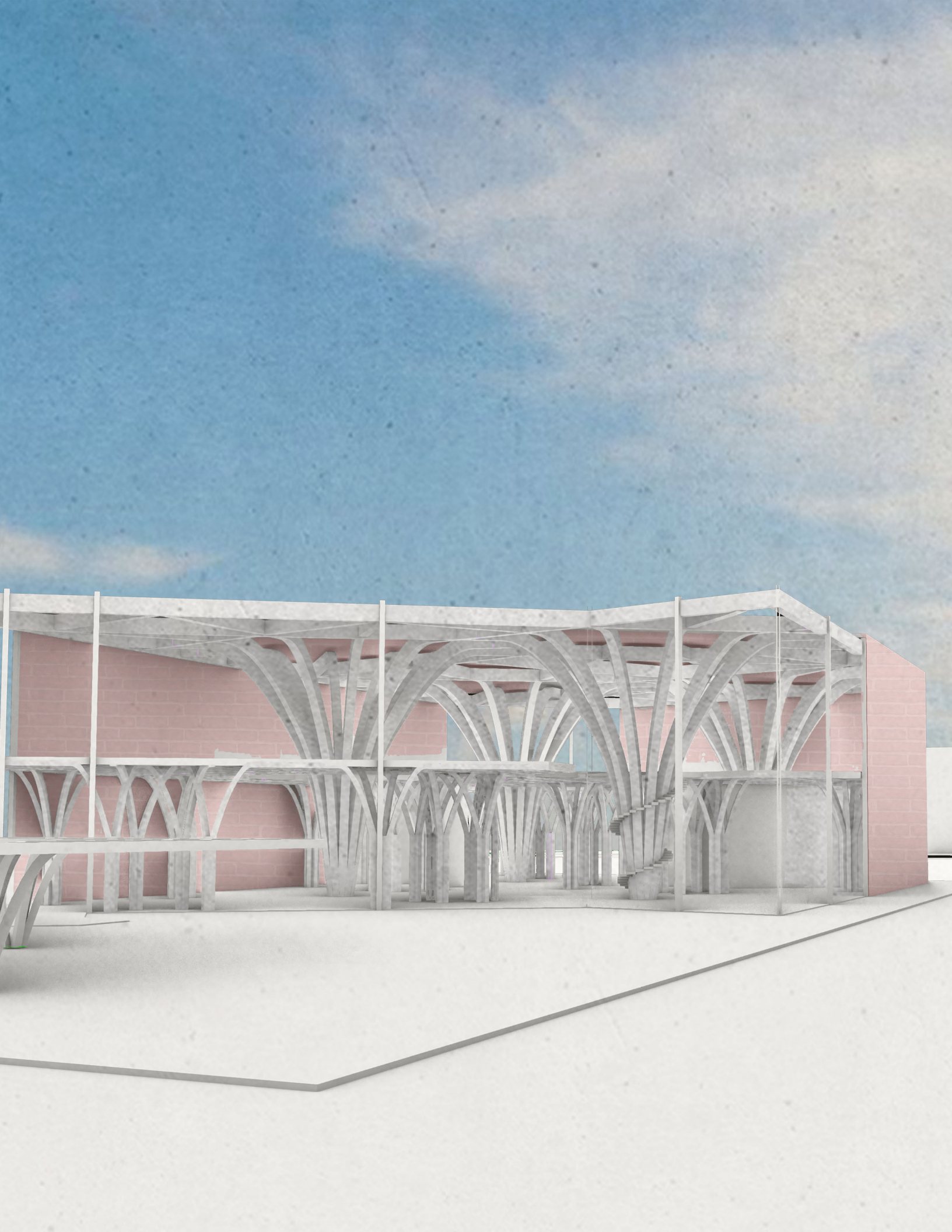
Onondaga Lake Community Center

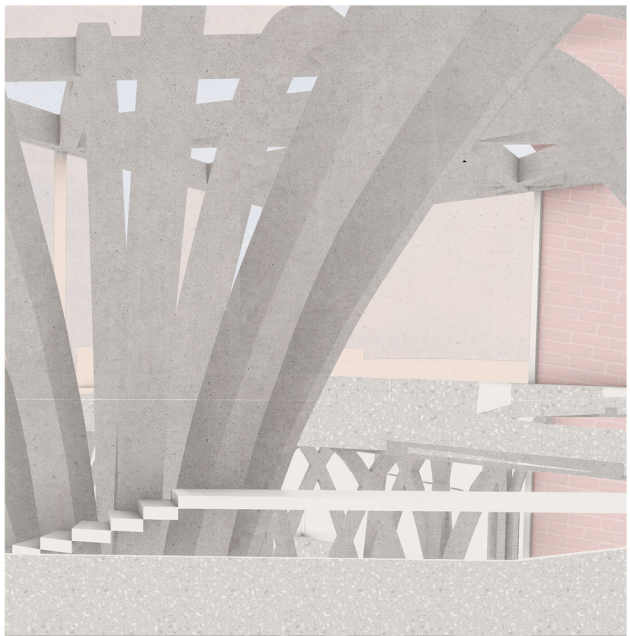
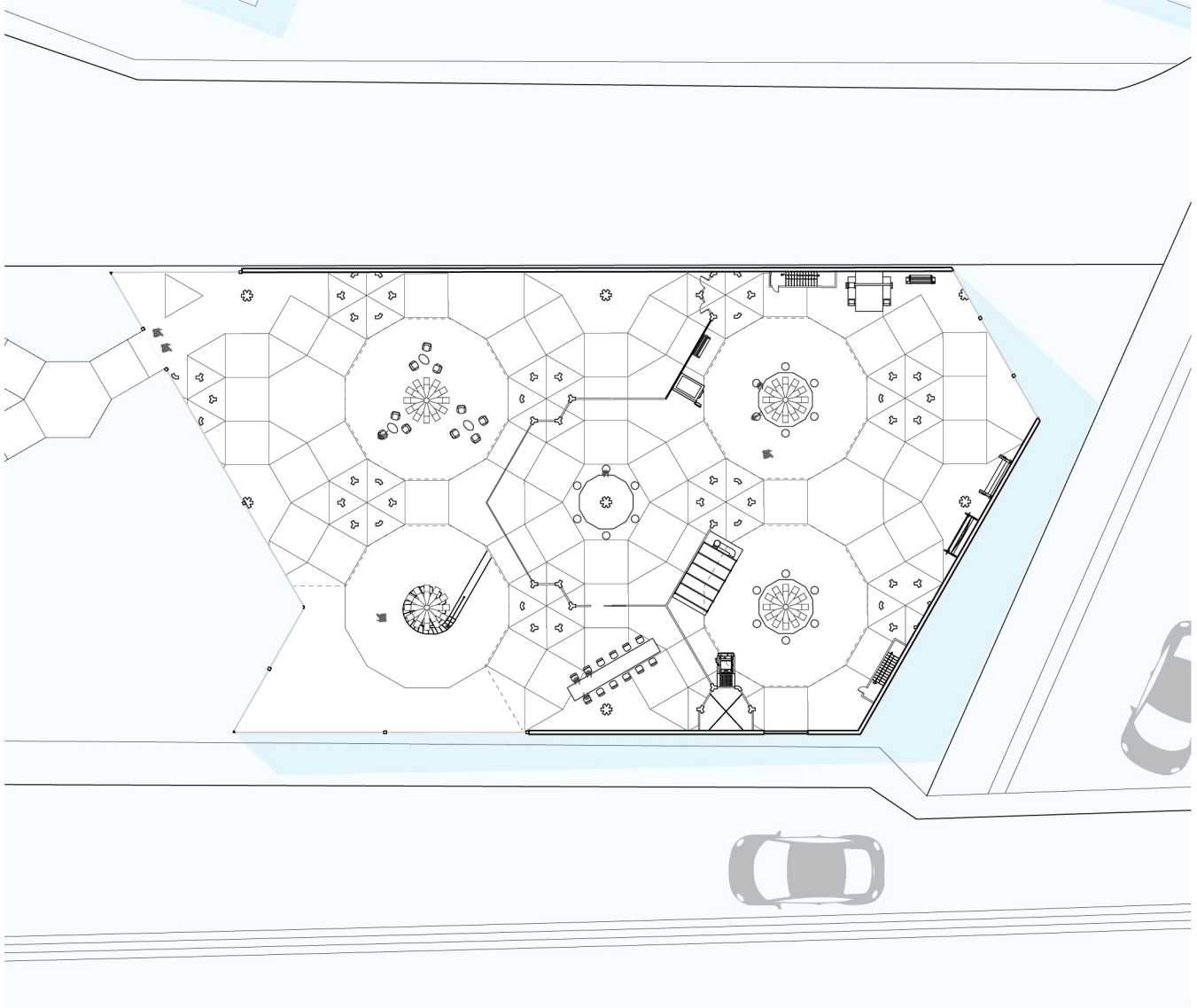


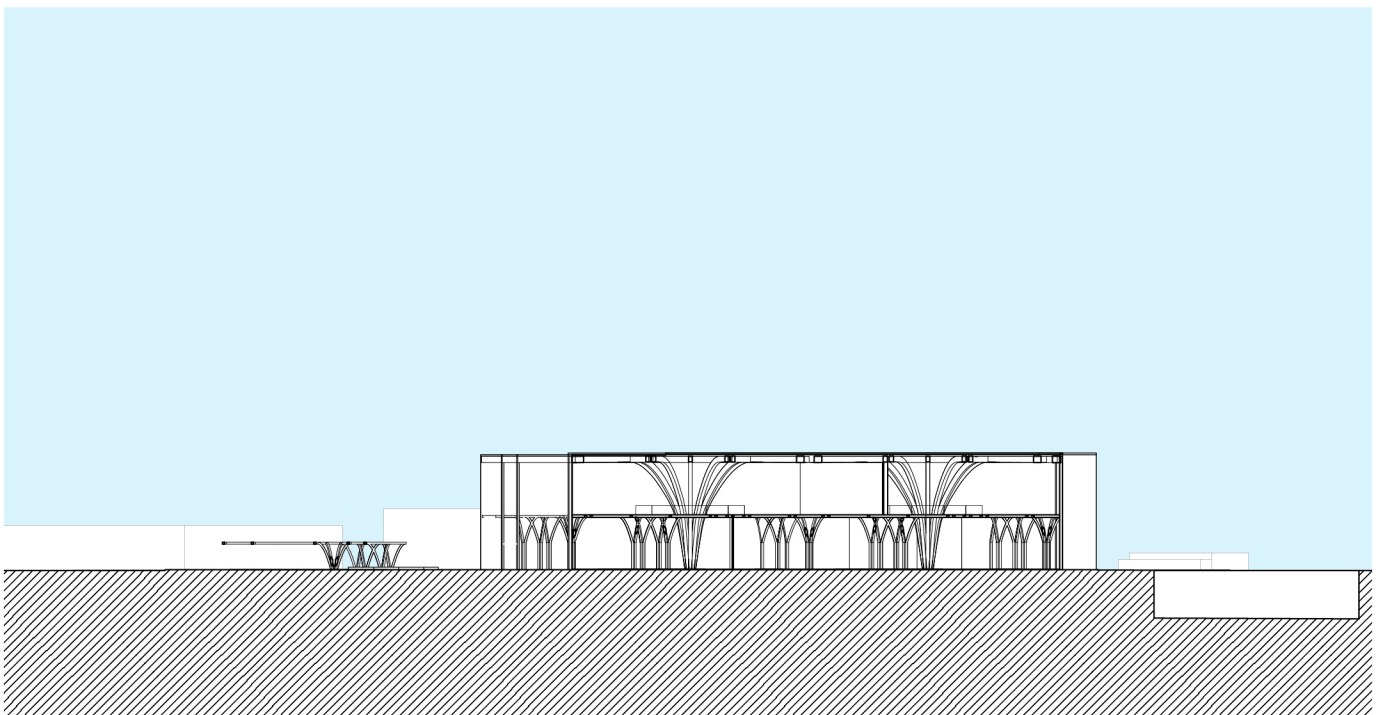


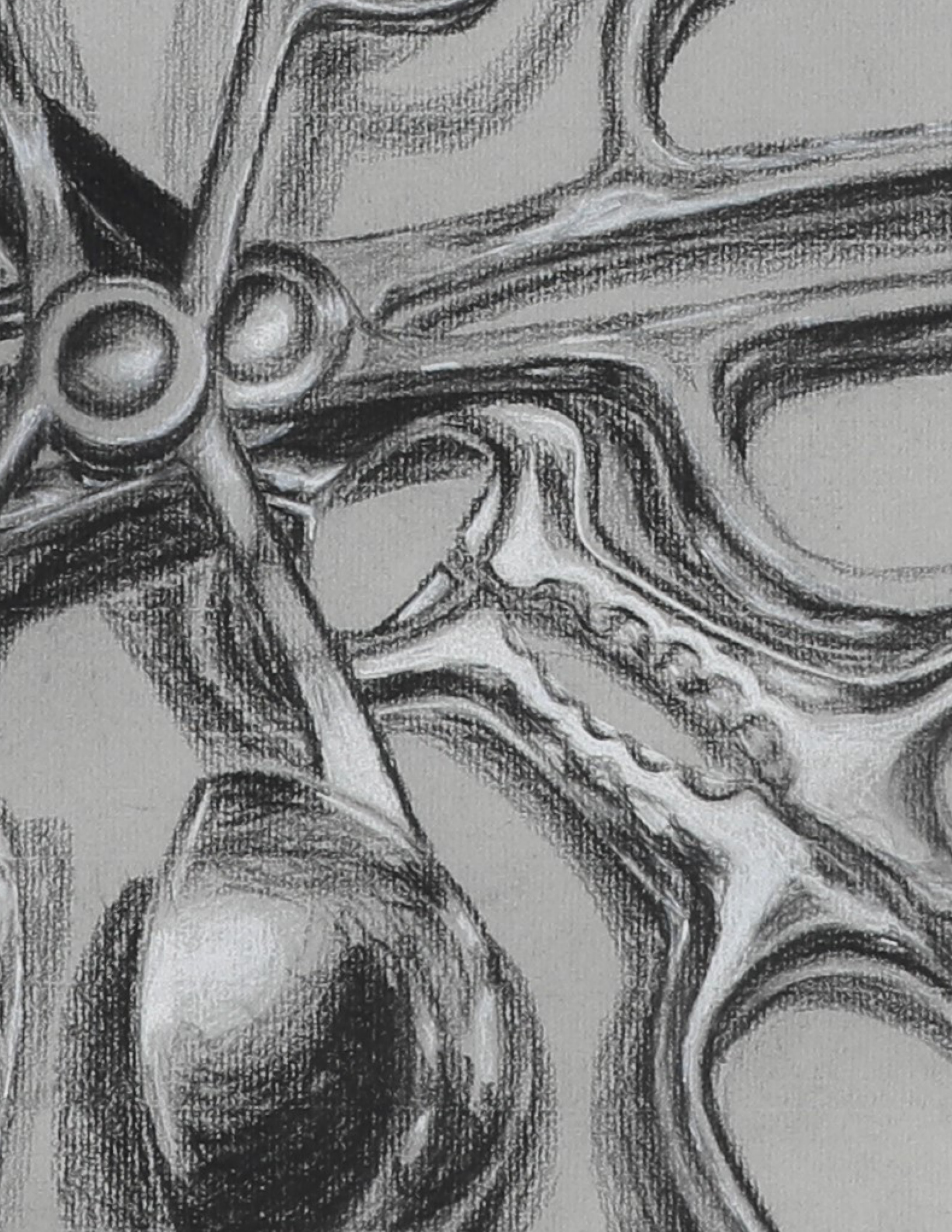
Forest of Columns

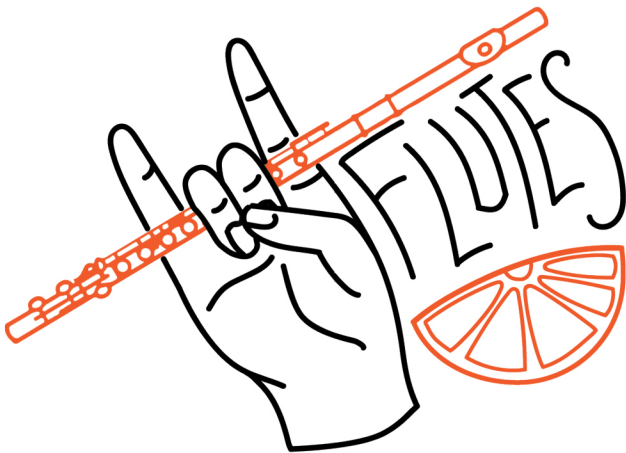
